





How can my organisation contribute in-kind to an IHI project?

Eligible in-kind contributions under IHI can only be provided by entities which are affiliated either to one of the founding associations of IHI or their affiliated National Associations, or via a specific application to become a <u>Contributing Partner</u>. However, there is only a limited budget available for Contributing Partners, and the rationale for an organisation to apply as such needs to be approved via the IHI Governing Board (IHI GB).

Your in-kind contribution as 'private member' via industry affiliation is eligible if you are:

- A direct member of at least one of the founding associations of IHI, check here: <u>COCIR</u>, <u>EFPIA</u>, <u>EuropaBio</u>, <u>MedTech Europe</u> or <u>Vaccines Europe</u>
- Affiliated indirectly to a private member, i.e. a member of one of the national associations listed <u>here</u>.

If this is not your case you may consider **applying for** <u>standard</u> **membership (links above)**, **or for** <u>specific</u> membership:

- EFPIA Partner in Research Membership, or EFPIA SME membership,
- MedTech Europe Partner in Research,
- COCIR Associate Membership.

These specific options allow your organisation to **contribute in-kind to any IHI project**, **via in-kind contributions to operational activities (IKOP) and in-kind contributions to additional activities (IKAA**), like any of the existing industry associations' members.
